

## MACHINE APPLIQUE

### Introduction

This is a bonded appliqué method. There is a choice of two designs, a cockerel or a Tree of Life.

### Requirements

- Background fabric approx 15” wide x 16” long
- Bondaweb approx 12” x 13”
- Stitch and Tear approx 12” x 13”
- Small pieces of fabric for cockerel – think bright colours!
- Largest piece is for body, approx 9” x 5”, 8 pieces for tail plus small pieces for legs, head and beak
- ***OR*** pieces of fabric for Tree of Life – largest piece will be for trunk of tree. Again, think bright
- Thread to match fabrics or ‘invisible’ monofilament thread
- Low-tack masking tape – don’t buy especially
- Tracing/greaseproof paper or similar approx 12” x 13”
- Fine permanent marker
- Pencil
- Eraser ( just in case!)
- Paper scissors
- Fabric scissors
- Pins
- Sewing machine with zig-zag stitch and all the necessary bits and pieces, including the manual. If you have an open-toed appliqué foot then bring it, but don't buy one especially

**Please** test your machine in the few days before the workshop. It is always a shame when people lose valuable workshop time sorting their machines out and I am no expert!
