

WOVEN QUILTS

The day will start with making a small sample quilt (approx 12" sq) to learn the techniques. After this a larger quilt can be planned and started.

Requirements - General

- Rotary cutting equipment. The mat needs to be 18" x 24". *If your mat isn't this big please let me know beforehand*
- Masking tape - don't buy especially
- Fabric marker - needs to be easily erasable (spontaneously/with water/with iron)
- Pins - ideally without large heads
- Sewing machine with manual and all feet. A walking foot will definitely help but isn't essential for this technique
- 2 metres of Bondaweb

Requirements - for sample quilt

- Two pieces of fabric approx 12" sq
- 14" sq wadding
- 14" sq fabric for backing
- Machine embroidery thread to stitch raw edges of strips or else monofilament thread

Requirements for larger quilt

- Two pieces of fabric approx 21" sq (i.e. two fat quarters)
- Small pieces of fabric for appliqué
- Machine embroidery thread to stitch raw edges of strips and to attach the appliqué pieces
- 23" sq wadding
- 23" sq fabric for backing
- Tulle (optional)

General

- The fabrics need to contrast with each other - for instance one plain one patterned/two different graded fabrics/one pink one blue
- The machine thread can be cotton, polyester, viscose, monofilament.....
