

## IMPROVERS QUILTING

This follows the same formula as the beginner's course (quilt as you go) but this time concentrating more on learning new techniques – celtic work, reverse appliqué, log cabin and strip piecing to name a few. A couple of the blocks are quicker with a machine but all can be done by hand.

### Requirements – needed every week

Pins

Needles

Threads – light, medium & dark values of brown or grey

Large fabric scissors

Small, pointed fabric scissors

Rotary cutting equipment – *if* you have it

Paper scissors

Ruler with ¼” marks

HB pencil & sharpener

Erasable fabric marker

Template plastic \*

Cereal box type card\*\*

Pritt stick\*\*

\* most templates can be made from cardboard but a few really do need to be made from template plastic.

\*\* If making all templates in plastic then you don't need these items
