

TWIST & TURN QUILT REQUIREMENTS

This quilt uses many different manipulated fabric techniques. The centre block is a Jennie Rayment design and she has kindly allowed me to use and teach it. The finished size is 39" square.

Fabric Choices - fabrics with large patterns or multiple colours don't really work for this style of patchwork. Batiks, solids, 'textures' (such as the Spraytime range), self-coloured patterns, small prints all work well.

The fabric needs to be purchased prior to the start of the course as week one is spent cutting it all up into the relevant shapes/sizes. Then you can relax!

Requirements

Background fabric - 1.5mtrs. I have used a light colour but it works very well with a darker colour

Fabric A - 1.0mtr. I have used this one in the centre block

Fabric B -70cms. This is my orange fabric

Fabric C - 60cms. This is my turquoise fabric. It's the 'zing' fabric

Fabric D - 40cms. This one is used for the triangles in the corners of most of the blocks.

Rotary cutting equipment - an 18" x 24" cutting mat is the ideal size; a 6" x 24" ruler (minimum size 3" x 18") and a rotary cutter with a SHARP blade

Erasable fabric marker

Small ruler for measuring seam allowances (6" x 1" if you have one)

Fabric scissors

Small, sharp, pointed scissors

Needles and pins

Threads to match all of the fabrics

Some of the blocks require an element of machine sewing. If it can be done at home I'll give you the details the week before. For any 'on-the-day' machining I will bring my machine in.
